

Dear Parents, Carers and Yokine families

Today the Premier announced whilst all public schools will remain open until the end of term, families are strongly encouraged to keep their children at home if they have the capacity to do so.

I would like to share with you what this will mean for our school community:

**Monday 30 March to Friday 3 April**

- All children who attend school will be taught as normal.

**Final week of Term – Monday 6 April to Thursday 9 April**

- Students who attend will be supervised, but not taught normal lessons.
- Teachers and education assistants will prepare teaching programs for Term 2.

**Term 2 – commencing Tuesday 28 April**

- At this stage the arrangements for Term 2 have not been finalised. The State Government is working on developing a longer term education model for Term 2 and beyond in response to COVID-19.

Please be assured that as further information is released I will be in contact with you. Information regarding the distribution of work packages to assist with your child's learning will be circulated tomorrow, Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March.

Please do not contact your child's classroom teacher.

I would like to thank you for your support and cooperation during this unprecedented situation. Your continued assistance and understanding means a great deal to us all.
