

Voluntary Contributions and Charges: 2018

Dear Parents and Caregivers

The Education Act 1999 requires schools to notify parents of the schedule of Voluntary Contributions and Charges for 2018. The Yokine Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2018. The Schedule covers four sections and will allow you to calculate all costs for 2018.

1. Voluntary Contributions: (Section 99)

- The total amount of contributions parents and carers are being asked to pay has to be set in accordance with School Education Regulation 2000.
- Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure in the purchase of resources needed in the provision of the learning program activities, examples are set out below:

Kindergarten to Year 6

Information and Communication Technology hardware and software	Physical Education Equipment
English resources	Music Resources
Science resources and consumables	Library Books
Mathematics resource	Art/Craft resources and consumables

These contributions are voluntary; **however, the quality of our teaching and learning program will be enhanced** when every family makes a contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources including the State and Federal Governments. The cost represents \$15 a term or less than 50c per day.

2. Yokine Primary School Digital Technology Fund /Building and Grounds Improvement Fund

Yokine PS Digital Technology Fund:

This fund was established and sanctioned by the School Board in 2012 to allow parents and community members to make a donation to support the school in developing our digital technology program K – Year 6 to ensure our students are supported in developing their skills and 21st century learning. Since 2013 the school has purchased 4 banks of tablets, 3 banks of Laptops and three laptop trolleys. In 2018 the school will purchase 16 iPads to support the STEM Program. This continues to support our direction in building the capacity of technology integration across the school. The initially purchased tablets will soon need replacing due to their age and we require another bank of laptops to support the integration of Digital Technologies with all learning areas. The total estimated cost of this is \$30,000.

Yokine PS Grounds Improvement Fund:

This was established and sanctioned by the School Board in 2014 to support the growing need of developing our grounds, and playgrounds and to bring us in line with current educational learning for the junior years (K- 2) and within the Mandated National Quality Standards for Early childhood Education and Care.

3. Extra Costs Associated with Optional Education Program: (Section 100)

A breakdown of **estimated charges** for your child's participation in expected class and school activities for 2018 has been included. Details on charges collected in previous years have assisted us in preparing the 2018 Additional Fees & Charges Schedule.

Included in this schedule is a **\$100 – Kindergarten to Year 6 Payment for Excursion and Incursion Expenses**. This is to cover a number of programs delivered throughout the year such as Class Excursion, Scitech day, and other whole school incursions. (This is extra to the \$60 Contribution/child). This payment should be made as part of the booklist order or as a separate payment during the school year.

The Upfront Payment has been more efficient for parents, teachers and school accounting processes. This payment assists the school in the efficient processing of excursion payments.

CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS

Credit card payments can be made using the QKR app:

Our (pronounced 'quicker') phone app is available for families of students at Yokine PS.

QKR by MasterCard can be downloaded for free from Apple's app store for iPhones (iPads should download the iPhone app) or from Google Play for Android phones and tablets.

After downloading the app and registering, simply select Yokine PS from 'Nearby Locations' on QKR or type **YOKPS** after tapping the magnifying glass in the top right of the home screen of QKR, and then the app will always recognise you as part of the school in future to make payments even easier.

You then simply need to set up your child/children and save your credit card details to get started.

QKR is safe, secure and fully backed by MasterCard and the Commonwealth Bank. All Credit Card details are encrypted meaning your information is not accessible and remains confidential.

3 rounds of PEAC courses

- Note: PEAC courses range in cost from \$10 to \$100 per round.
- Students can choose from a range of ~40 courses of varying costs.
- Round 1 for Year 5 students is a foundation *Introduction to PEAC* course and costs \$30
- Payment for the Year 4 Induction Day is due with the Round 1 Year 5 ITP course cost. For any children who attend the Induction but do not attend in 2018, costs will be charged separately.
